Existing Control Measures

4. Always wear suitable protective equipment including gloves and eye protection.
5. First Aid measures: General information, Treat symptomatically. If ingested rinse mouth thoroughly with water. Give plenty of water to drink. Do not induce vomiting. Get medical attention if any discomfort continues. If inhaled breath in fresh air.
6. If in contact with skin, wash skin thoroughly with soap and water. Remove contaminated clothing. Get medical attention if irritation persists after washing.
7. Eye contact - rinse immediately with plenty of water. Continue to rinse for at least 15 minutes. Get medical attention if any discomfort continues.
8. Do not discharge into drains or watercourses or onto the ground.
9. Contain and absorb spillage with sand, earth or other non-combustible material. Collect and place in suitable waste disposal containers and seal securely.
10. Keep separate from food, feedstuffs, fertilisers and other sensitive material. Store in closed original container at temperatures between 5°C and 30°C. Protect from freezing and direct sunlight.
11. Chemical-resistant, impervious gloves complying with an approved standard should be worn if a risk assessment indicates skin contact is possible.

12. Disposal methods Collect and place in suitable waste disposal containers and seal securely. Dispose of waste product or used containers in accordance with local regulations All empty packaging to be returned to region and disposed of in Drum A EWC 08 04 10
