Existing Control Measures
1. Always use in a well ventilated area
2. Ingestion Rinse mouth thoroughly with water. Give plenty of water to drink. Do not induce vomiting. Get medical attention if any discomfort continues.
3. Skin contact - Wash skin thoroughly with soap and water. Remove contaminated clothing. Get medical attention if irritation persists after washing.
4. Eye contact - Rinse immediately with plenty of water. Continue to rinse for at least 15 minutes. Get medical attention if any discomfort continues
5. Suitable extinguishing media - The product is not flammable. Use fire-extinguishing media suitable for the surrounding fire.
6. Hazardous combustion products - Does not decompose when used and stored as recommended.
7. Personal precautions Wear protective gloves, eye and face protection.
8. Environmental precautions - Do not discharge into drains or watercourses or onto the ground.
9. Methods for cleaning up - Contain and absorb spillage with sand, earth or other non-combustible material. Collect and place in suitable waste disposal containers and seal securely.
10. Provide adequate ventilation. Good personal hygiene procedures should be implemented.
11. Storage precautions - Protect from freezing and direct sunlight. Keep away from food, drink and animal feeding stuffs. Store in tightly-closed, original container.
12. Chemical-resistant, impervious gloves complying with an approved standard should be worn

13. Eyewear complying with an approved standard should be worn

14. Conditions to avoid - Avoid freezing. Avoid exposure to high temperatures or direct sunlight.

15. Empty containers are to be returned to the region and disposed of in Drum A EWC 08 04 10
