<b>Existing Control Measures</b>
1. Always use in a well ventilated area.

2. First Aid Measures: By inhalation: This product is not classified as hazardous through inhalation. However, in case of intoxication symptoms it is recommended to remove the person affected from the area of exposure, provide clean air and keep at rest. Request medical attention if symptoms persist.
3. By skin contact: May cause an allergic skin reaction. In case of contact it is recommended to clean the affected area thoroughly with water and neutral soap. In case of changes on the skin (stinging, redness, rashes, blisters,...), seek medical advice with this Safety Data Sheet
4. Skin contact Remove contaminated clothing. Rinse immediately with plenty of water. Get medical attention if any discomfort continues. Eye contact Rinse immediately with plenty of water. Continue to rinse for at least 15 minutes and get medical attention.
5. Waste treatment methods: Code Description Waste class 10 13 11 wastes from cement-based composite materials other than those mentioned in 10 13 09 and 10 13 10 Not dangerous
6. By ingestion/aspiration: Do not induce vomiting, but if it does happen keep the head down to avoid aspiration. Keep the person affected at rest. Rinse out the mouth and throat, as they may have been affected during ingestion
7. Personal precautions Avoid inhalation of dust. Avoid contact with skin and eyes
8. Environmental precautions Do not discharge into drains or watercourses or onto the ground
9. Methods and material for containment and cleaning up: It is recommended: Sweep up and shovel product or collect by other means and place in container for reuse (preferred) or disposal
10. Usage precautions Avoid handling which leads to dust formation. Good personal hygiene procedures should be implemented. Do not eat, drink or smoke when using the product.
11. Storage precautions Store in tightly-closed, original container. Keep separate from food, feedstuffs, fertilisers and other sensitive material. Store in a dry place.
